Overall Aim & description of the unit/topic:	Students explore the concept of worldview, with an emphasis on Christian worldview and the biblical connections, while examining the relationship between belief systems and personal development through the topic of democracy. Students analyse several worldviews through the contemporary issue of equality by exploring the response of various religious and non-religious worldviews to this value.
